

**CUMBERLAND COUNCIL**  
**INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT**

1. The name of the school is **Ireby Church of England Primary School**.
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is "**The governing body of Ireby Church of England Primary School**".
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. 3 parent governors
  - b. 1 LA governor
  - c. 1 staff governor
  - d. 1 headteacher
  - e. 2 foundation governors
  - f. 2 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors 10.
6. The term of office for all categories of governors is 4 years.
7. The Diocesan Board of Education shall appoint one foundation governor, after consulting the PCC of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated.
8.
  - (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The Principal Officiating Minister of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated.
  - (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
9. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
10. A Trust exists for the school.
11. Ireby Church of England Primary School provides education and collective worship in accordance with the principles and practices of the Church of England. Religious

Education and Spiritual Development are at the heart of every aspect of the work of this school.

12. This instrument of government comes into effect on 12 October 2023
